Trinity Sunday: Celebrating Our God beyond Understanding

This Sunday we celebrate the festival of the Holy Trinity which is the wonder of relationship with God. This wondering may be limited by our human understanding of what God is, but we are beloved by God regardless of our understanding. Sunday we will try and guard against the idolatry of language as we survey our scripture, creeds, and symbols of our heritage to explore our three-in-one God who is the fountain of living water, the rock who gave us birth, our light and salvation.

Sunday's gospel contains one of the few biblical references to the trinitarian formula.




Links to the Readings

Genesis 1:1-2:4a - The creation of the heavens and the earth Psalm 8 - How majestic is your name in all the earth! 2 Corinthians 13:11-13 - Paul's farewell to the church at Corinth Matthew 28:16-20 - Living in the community of the Trinity As the eleven are commissioned to make disciples, baptize, and teach, we are invited to consider our calling to influence the world with the good news of God's love. The text from Second Corinthians also includes a kind of naming of the Holy Trinity in an affectionate sign-off of a personal letter. With the psalm praising God the creator and sustainer of all creation, Genesis 1 relates the first of two creation stories, this one an ancient liturgy celebrating God as a divine plural.

That God that is beyond our understanding may be both troubling and comforting. The temptation may be to attempt to apprehend the idea of God with our intellect, offering we who gather in worship a showcase of various models for God. The result is usually disappointing and feeds our bias toward intellectualism. Another possibility is to celebrate God's presence in all its glory and colorful wonder and our belonging to this wonder-full God.

May God inspire fresh, innovative ideas in us and All the gathered Saints in this time and place, **Bill+**

Return of the Common Cup as an Option




On Pentecost, following guidance from Bishop +Rob to clergy and discussion with our Worship and Music Team and Vestry, we began the option of receiving wine by common cup as we offer the option of gluten free bread during Holy Communion. The Eucharistic Ministers will continue to distribute wine via individual cups and if you desire the common cup*, please ask Pastor Bill (just as you would for gluten free).

***Note:** For sanitation concerns and at the direction of our bishop, we will no longer offer the opportunity for Intinction (the dipping of the bread/wafer into the wine. ble for drinking from

New Bible Study Begins Thursday, June 8th



We celebrate the Feast of Pentecost on May 28th and ask you to wear red to church that day as it is the liturgical color of the day. Our worship space will reflect the color as we remember the descent of the Holy Spirit on that first Day of Pentecost following the Resurrection and Ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ. Pentecost Sunday initiates a whole season of Pentecost, or Ordinary Time, in which we remember that the whole of the Christian life, indeed the whole life of the Church is 'pneumatic', that is fueled and furthered by the powerful work of the Holy Spirit.
